Update on Influenza A H1N1

On Monday one case of Influenza A H1N1 was reported in one of the Year 1 classes. Subsequently, three more have been reported to us from the same class. The additional three cases occurred shortly after the first case was reported. All these children were not in school this week; therefore there was no immediate threat to the other children.

Please be assured that we do liaise closely with the Selangor Health Department and keep up to date with the current information for Influenza A H1N1 and act on their advice. As a school, we continue to ensure that the students wash their hands regularly during the day and that the classroom and equipment in daily use is cleaned regularly. This is in line with the guidance from the World Health Organisation on the prevention of the spread of viruses.

Please help us to monitor your children at home. Remember that students having a temperature of 38°C and above should not come to school and the respective School Secretary should be notified. Conversely, students in school with these temperatures will be sent home.
