

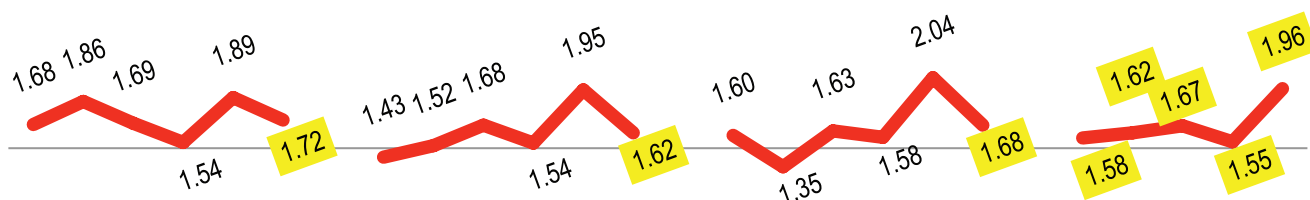

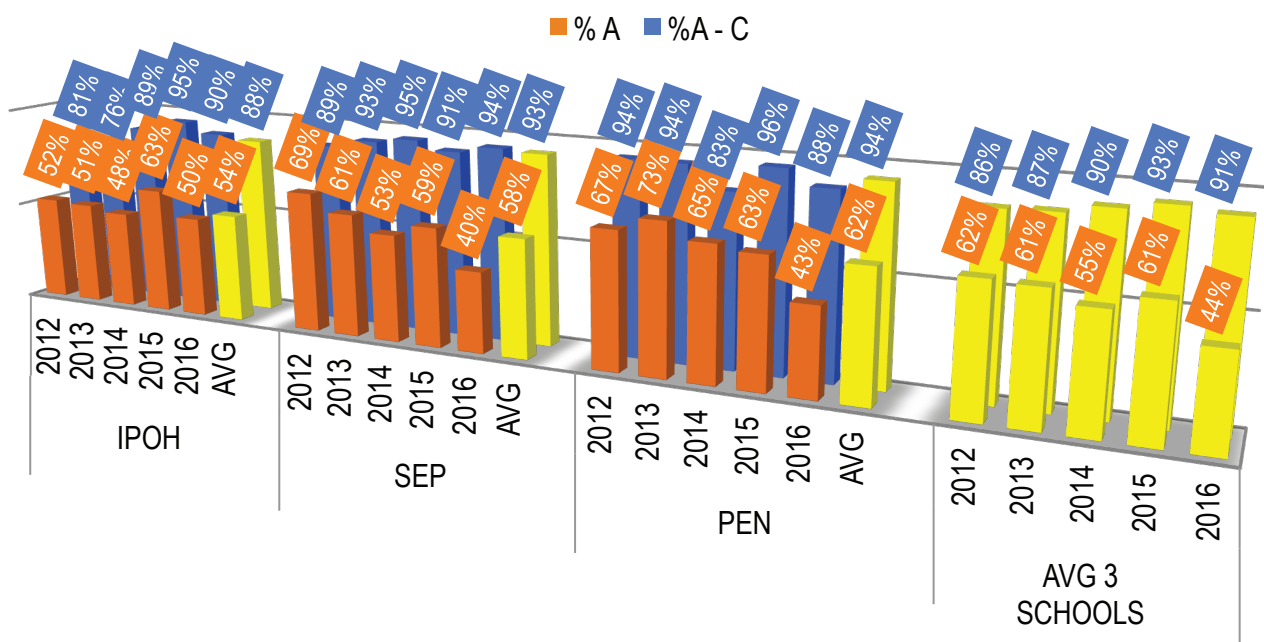

SEKOLAH SRI TENBY UPSR GPA 2012 - 2016

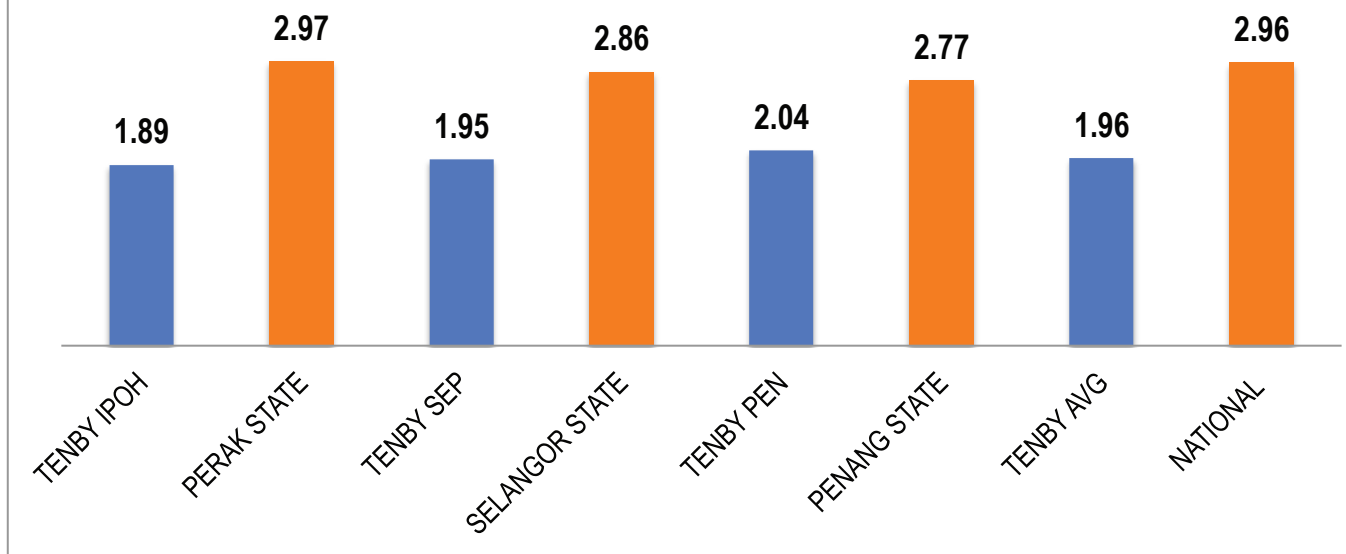

This year's UPSR group of students is the first batch following the new format. In the UPSR examination in 2016, candidates sat for 6 papers instead of 5. There were 2 papers for each subject, Bahasa Melayu, English, Mathematics and Science. However in the reporting of the grades for the language paper there are 2 grades, one for Comprehension and the other for Writing. For Science and Mathematics, though there are two papers, there is only 1 grade reported for each subject.

With this new format and with more **Higher Order Thinking Skills (HOTS)** questions in the examination, there has been a drop in the performance not only in Tenby but in the whole country too. The overall **Grade Point Average (GPA)** for all 3 schools has declined compared to that of the previous years.

Though the GPA of the 3 schools has dropped they are still better than the national GPA of 2.96. The number of Top Performers in the country too has dropped drastically with only 4,896 students (1.1%) scoring all As compared to 38,344 students in 2015. This drop could be attributed to the new format of the examination, and the number of HOTS questions set for all the subjects and the raising of the marks for A to 90.
