

Tenby Schools Malaysia Analysis PT3 Results 2016

Since 2014, the format for Form 3 examinations has changed. Previously all the subjects taken are tested in one sitting in September/October. But with the PT3 format, course work for subjects like History and Geography have been included. So students only sit the written test for Bahasa Malaysia (Malay Language), English, Science, Mathematics, Living Skills, Chinese Language and Islamic studies.

In 2016, another change was added. The Malay and English Language now have 2 papers each – one is written and the other is the oral component. So the minimum number of grades scored by a candidate is 9 (without the Chinese Language or Islamic Studies). The maximum could be 11 with the 2 subjects included.

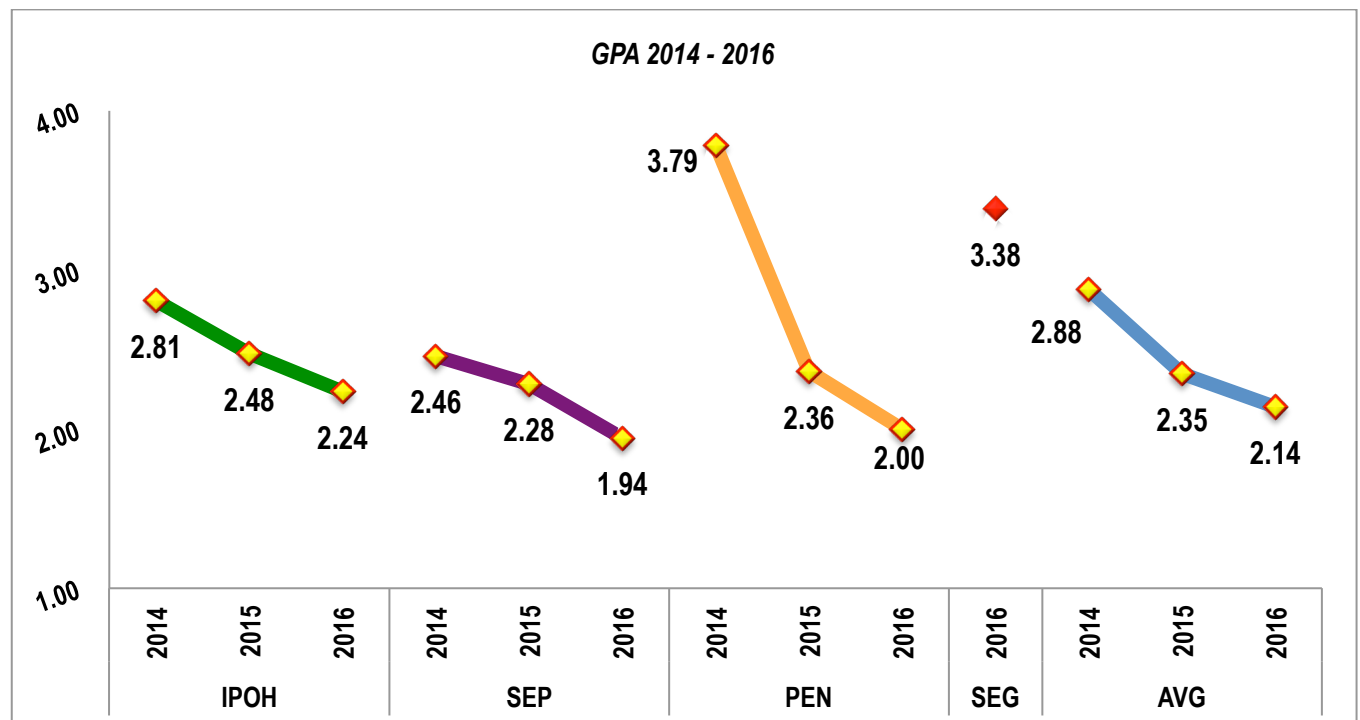
In 2016, the PT3 results have shown a marked improvement from 2014 in terms of the Grade Point Average (GPA)

Ipo improved from **2.81** to **2.24**

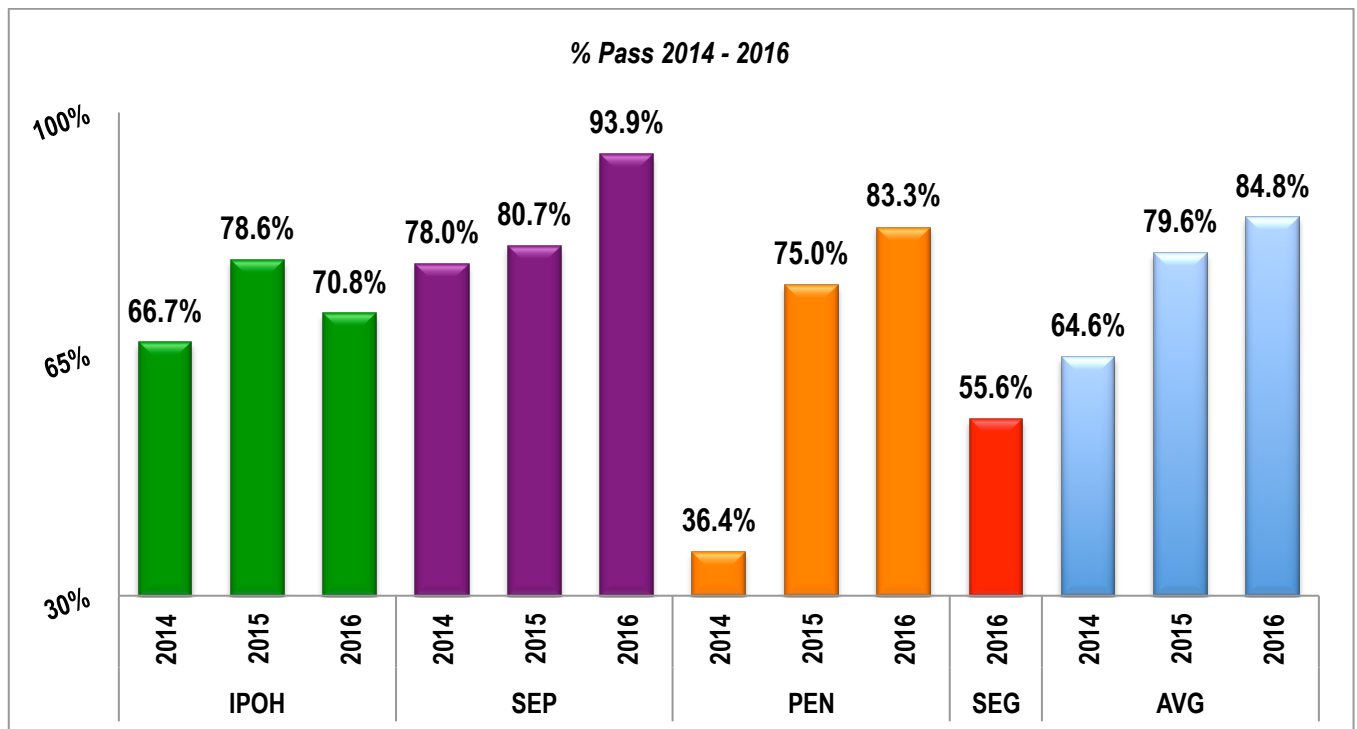
SEP improved from **2.46** to **1.94**

Penang improved from **3.79** to **2.00**

The best GPA for 2016 is still SEP with 1.94 followed closely by Penang with 2.00. Penang should be commended for this marked improvement in the quality of their performance. The GPA for SEG is 3.38. This is the first batch of PT3 students for SEG and so it has no previous data for comparison. Nevertheless the GPA is relatively low compared to other Tenby Schools.

The percentage pass for the school is calculated on the total number of students who pass every single subject taken (ie. achieve minimum of E). In terms of % Pass, SEP has the best results closely followed by Penang and Ipoh.

If we look at the results for the last 3 years from 2014 – 2016, Penang and SEP have shown marked improvement in the percentage pass. Penang from 36.36% in 2014 to 83.33% in 2016 and SEP from 78% in 2014 to 93.94% in 2016. Ipoh's results have been fluctuating in the 60% to 80% range.

As for top scorers SEP is the only school with 1 student scoring A for every subject taken (total 9 subjects). SEP too has more than 57% and Ipoh 38% scoring 5 As and above (the maximum number of subject is 11).

As a group our best performance is in English both written (1.61) and oral (1.45). The subject of concern to Tenby is Science with a group GPA of 3.10. The performance in Science has affected the quantity and quality of Tenby School. For example, in Ipoh not a single student was able to score an A in Science. Thus, overall, no students in Ipoh were able to score all As in all the subjects.

A science workshop was held in 20th August 2016 to try to encourage more creative and innovative ways of teaching science with an emphasis on higher order thinking questions. Currently the Science teachers in Tenby, especially those teaching in the national schools, have been linked together through a Google link and WhatsApp to share good practices among themselves. We hope that the results for Science will improve in 2017.

There is an urgent need for Tenby Schools to expand the initiative that has been taken for Science to improve the quality and quantity of students' performance in other subjects.
