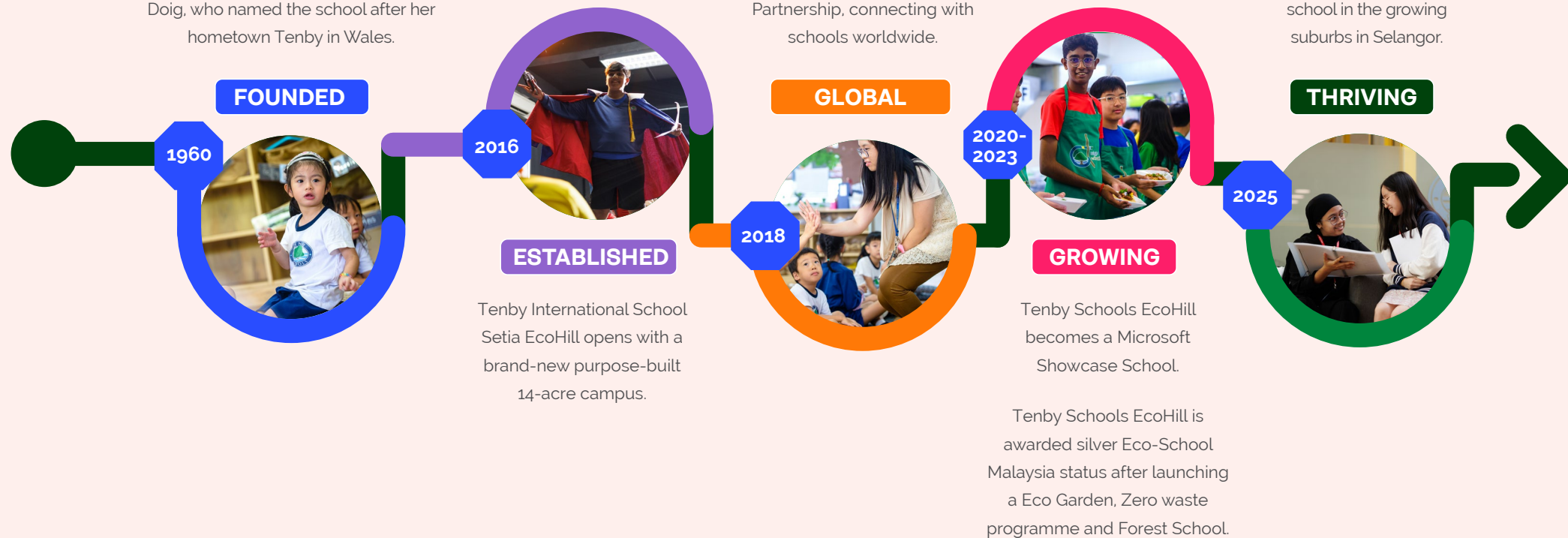

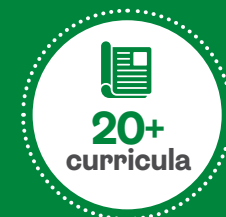

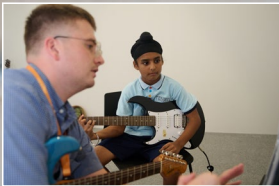

For those with a love of sport and physical activity, our swimming pools, wading pool, football field and various facilities provide ample opportunity to discover new passions and develop essential life skills.





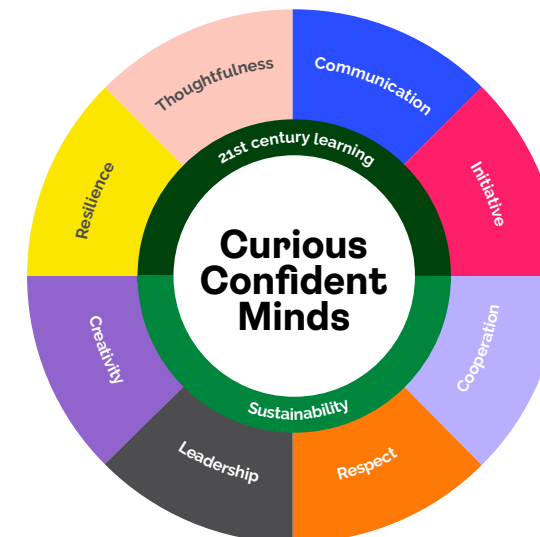

How is my child supported?

Your child's first school experience is so important—it shapes how they'll approach learning throughout their life.

At Tenby International School Setia EcoHill, we aim to spark a natural curiosity in children, inspiring excitement and motivation towards learning both inside and outside the classroom.

What will they learn?

Physical Development: Promoting fitness, coordination, and teamwork, our activities develop strong motor skills and encourage healthy habits from a young age.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development: We help children build confidence through activities, expressing preferences, and discussing emotions in a supportive environment.

Language: We believe in a world where communication is key. All our Early Years students have weekly lessons in Bahasa Malaysia and Mandarin with specialist teachers.

English: We focus on linking English letters and sounds, exploring texts and poetry, and building writing skills, ensuring they're Primary ready.

Mathematics: We emphasise problem-solving, counting, number use, and early calculations, alongside shapes and measurement.

Understanding the World: Children explore connections between people, history, geography, and Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) as well as becoming digitally literate.

Literacy: We help children develop strong English reading and writing skills so by the end of their time in Early Years they're confident and ready for the next stage.

Arts and Design: Creativity shines through music, dance, drama, and a variety of materials.

Our curriculum, based on the National Curriculum for England (NCUK), that blends with the global focus of the International Primary Curriculum (IPC), provides a strong foundation for your child's future success.

Our learning approach helps build your child's confidence, life skills and prepares them for a lifetime of success – inside and outside the classroom.

Your child will progress through two key stages: Key Stage 1 (Years 1-2) and Key Stage 2 (Years 3-6). Our specialist teachers, dedicated to nurturing the unique potential in your child's potential. Embracing our Learning.First™ approach, we're here to guide your child in becoming a passionate, lifelong learner, ready to explore, challenge, and discover.

What will they learn?

English: We foster a love for reading and writing, building literacy, and confidence through phonics and interactive storytelling.

Mathematics: We emphasis on problem-solving and reasoning skills through engaging math activities, to make math clear and enjoyable.

Science: The curriculum promotes curiosity, encouraging children to think like young scientists through hands-on experiments.

Computing: Students develop coding, digital literacy, and problem-solving skills using Byte-Ed and VEX Robotics, preparing them for the digital future through interactive and engaging projects.

Music: Students explore music through instrument lessons, singing, and performances, fostering creativity and teamwork, with professional lessons offered as extracurriculars.

PSHE: Personal, Social & Health Education help us manage emotions, build relationships, and learn about mental health, wellbeing, and community roles.

Physical Education: Physical Education classes promote fitness, teamwork, and coordination through sports and activities, encouraging a healthy lifestyle.

Languages: Students can choose daily or twice-weekly Mandarin lessons, which include music and performance, fostering cultural awareness and communication skills.

Art: Students are encouraged to express creativity and develop artistic skills through various mediums, including drawing, painting, sculpture, and digital design. This subject foster critical thinking, visual communication, and cultural awareness.

IT: Students learn coding, digital literacy, internet safety, and use modern software, enhancing problem-solving and critical-thinking skills to prepare for the digital future.

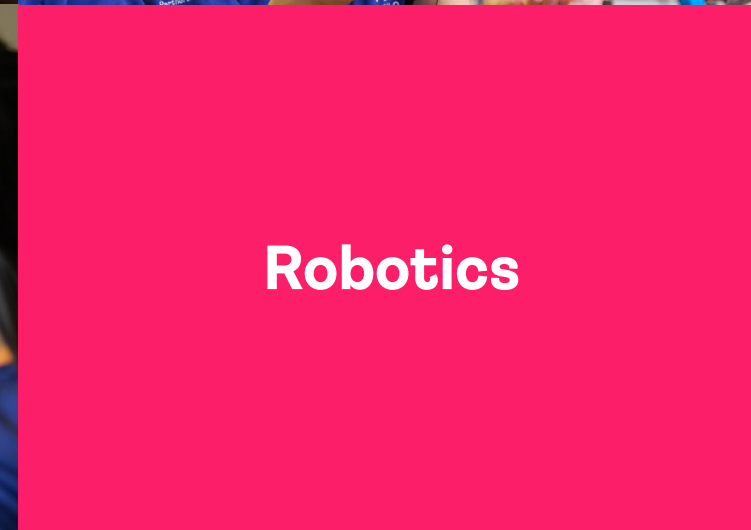

Our co-curricular activities (CCA) clubs are taught by our team of specialist teachers and qualified international and external instructors to ensure a safe and enjoyable learning environment.

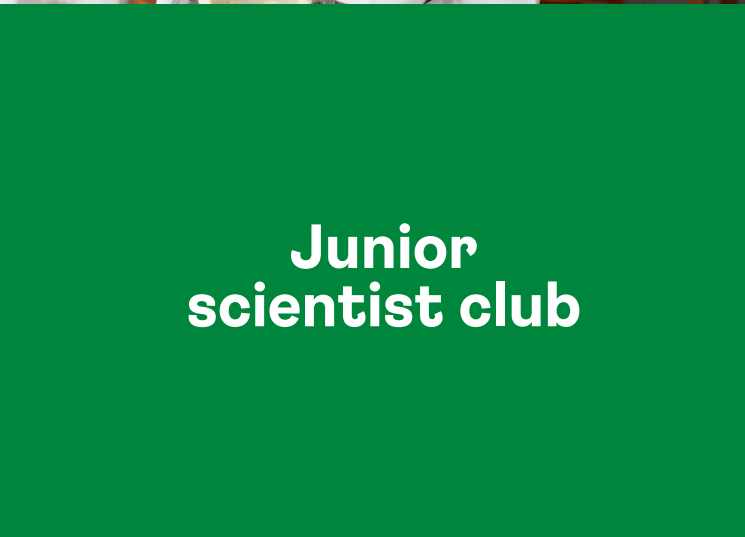

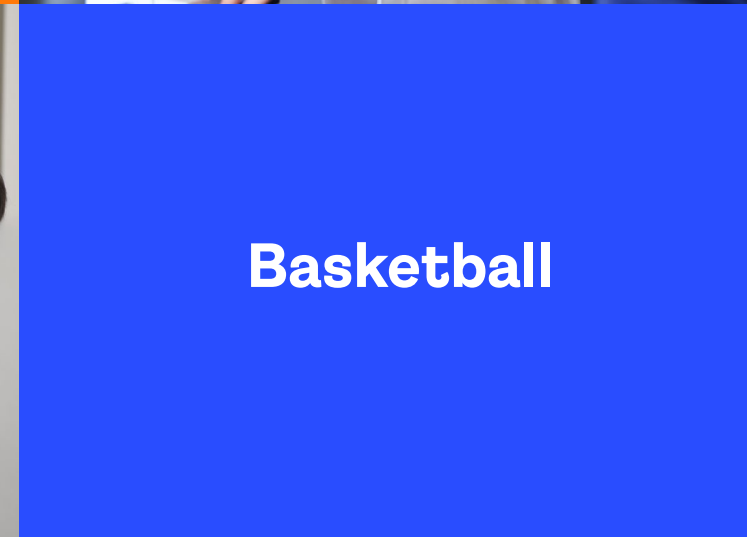

School Life

Putting student safety first

Safeguarding is in everything we do at Tenby Schools. All our staff community, ranging from security guards to the Campus Principal play a part in keeping us all safe. Furthermore, our campus has a dedicated Safeguarding team who take responsibility for ensuring that all students are safe when at school. Here are some of the measures we have in place:

- School nurse on site
- All staff and parents wear identification
- Designated student toilets
- Undertaking police checks before recruiting staff
- Ensuring teacher and staff are first aid trained
- Patrolling security guards at entrance and exit points
- CCTV surveillance

Technology

Being digitally literate is a core skill and this is embedded throughout our curriculum. Along with specialist devices for computer science, design, science and music, we also have a range of devices to support primary learning, such as iPads and Winbooks. In Secondary, we assist our students with a Bring Your Own Device Scheme.

Keeping our students safe online

All our devices are protected by Smoothwall, which helps protect children's devices at school by providing advanced web filtering and monitoring tools. It ensures that students can safely access educational content while blocking harmful or inappropriate websites. Smoothwall's technology works in real-time, detecting and preventing online threats such as cyberbullying, explicit content,

or malware. Additionally, it allows school administrators to set custom filters tailored to age-appropriate content, ensuring a secure digital environment for learning. With Smoothwall, we can create a safer online experience for our students while maintaining educational access.

Lunchtime

Students are able to choose their own meal in our canteen or parents can order in advance. We have a cashless system so students can pay using their Vircle Card, which can be topped up easily by parents.

Uniform

We want our community to look smart and have pride in their appearance. Our uniforms are different in primary and secondary and on PE days students wear their PE kit.

School timings

The different stages of school have slightly different school day timings. After the school day is finished, all students can stay on for extracurricular clubs until 4:00pm.

- Early Years students can be dropped off from 7:50am and the day ends at 3:00pm
- Primary School start at 7:50am and ends at 3:00pm
- Secondary School starts at 7:50 and ends at 3:00pm.

Parents' Association

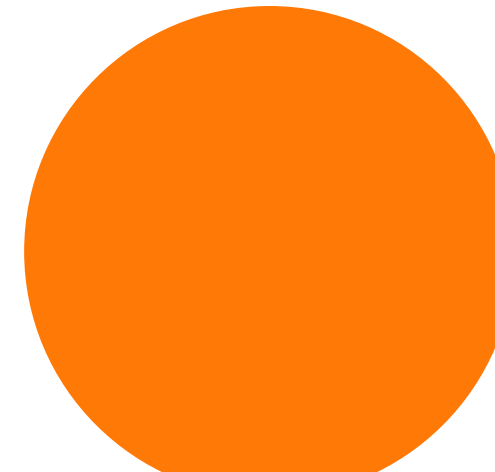
Parental involvement is key to a successful school environment, and we strongly believe that when parents and the school work hand in hand, it facilitates a strong learning community that impacts and encourages students to be their best. Our Tenby School Parent Association (TSPA) is thriving organisation and helps the school with events, welcome meetings for parents and cultural celebrations.

Pastoral care

At our school, we place great importance on pastoral care, ensuring every child feels supported and cared for. Kindness and compassion are central to our values, and each student has a dedicated adult-whether it's a key worker, teacher, or form tutor-overseeing their well-being. Our school counsellor is always available, and to help new students settle in, we assign them a buddy. This ensures that everyone feels welcome and quickly adjusts to their new school environment.

Supporting non-English speakers

Our students come to us from many different backgrounds, with many different language needs. The Learning Centre (TLC) is our own dedicated learning support hub on campus. We provide English as an Additional Language (EAL) classes to support all non-native English speakers. Our specialist teachers will work on a customised plan for each student who requires support. Submit application



Applications are accepted throughout the year, pending on space. Our admissions team will assist you with the application and any necessary paperwork for employers or visa applications.

Application review



Once your application is reviewed, we'll reach out with the next steps which may include an assessment and/or interview depending on the supporting documents included in your application and your current age.

Offer



There are three possible outcomes of the assessment. The first is Successful and you will be issued an offer letter. The second is Not Ready yet which means further discussion is needed about a start date and the third is a Conditional offer which may set out specific goals to be agreed by parents and the school before the child starts.

Secure your place



To accept the offer, provide any outstanding documents and pay the registration fee and deposit to secure your child's place and enrol. We will then help with MOE approval and any student or guardian visas.
