Tenby Schools' priority is the well being of our students and staff during a haze situation.

The well being of our students remains a key priority. Teachers will be on the lookout for students who are unwell and ensure that these students receive medical attention promptly. For students who have pre-existing heart or lung conditions, the school has a list of these students' names and will also be monitoring them.

As children respond differently to haze, parents should ensure their children have their medication, such as inhalers for asthma, with them. Parents should also take their children to seek medical attention if they are unwell and ensure that their children take their medication to school or arrange for alternative care arrangements to care for them at home.

All outdoor activities will be suspended.</p> <p>At Tenby we are fortunate to have classrooms that are equipped with air-conditioning so that the students' exposure to the haze is as minimal as possible. The following arrangements should be made:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Children may bring a packed snack and lunch to school and eat in air-conditioned classrooms.• The Cafeteria are on standby to create foods that are pre-packed so that students can 'grab and go' and eat in their classrooms.• There will be no outside play at break times.• Indoor CCAs will continue. Outdoor ones will be cancelled.• We encourage parents to provide students with appropriate

	<p>masks (N95) to wear in school.</p> <p>There are occasions where the Ministry of Education (MOE) will declare schools closure under this category (API reading). The school will adhere to the MOE's directive in this instance, unless permission is given to do otherwise.</p>
<p>201 – 300 (Very Unhealthy)</p>	<p>Under such circumstances, school will be closed for all students and teachers as instructed by the MOE. The school will adhere to the MOE's directive in this instance, unless permission is given to do otherwise.</p> <p>The following arrangements should be made if the school is open:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attendance for school is not compulsory and will not be recorded as absent. • Some students (e.g. those in exams classes) might be encouraged to return to school for classroom lessons. • Please ensure that the students have suitable face masks (N95) to wear. • Haze work will be uploaded onto the website for students that didn't attend school. <p>If the API reading reaches 201 or above during school hours, parents are allowed to pick their children up from school upon informing the school prior to the pick up.</p>
<p>>300 (Hazardous)</p>	<p>School will be closed</p>
