Traffic Flow

We are pleased to inform parents that this morning the jam at the roundabout coming into school had cleared by 07:45hrs. This was mainly due to cars stopping four at a time at each drop off point, and students exiting the vehicles quickly, which proves that with the cooperation of everyone, we can overcome the traffic situation at both drop off and pick up times.

However, the traffic at the roundabout still continues to be a problem. Cars are still coming into school using lanes which they should NOT. We reiterate that parents that choose not to follow the correct lanes, they are the ones who 'cut queues' and cause much stress for other parents who do follow the correct lanes. We continue to urge our community to be considerate to each other.

Block A and D – Left Hand Lane

Please approach the school from the immigration office side, keeping in the left hand lane at all times. *Please do not create a double lane queue as we need to leave the road free for non-school users and emergency vehicles in particular.*

For vehicles needing the left-hand lane but approaching from the Meru Desa Park direction, it is necessary for you to turn left at the roundabout and do a U-turn and join the queue on the left-hand lane. **DO NOT** cross straight over the roundabout and cut in. We have noted some parents are making the U turn as requested and we commend them for doing the right thing.

Block B and E – Right Hand Lane

Please approach the school from the Meru Desa Park direction, *do not come passed the immigration building as it will cause too much traffic congestion and block the right-hand lane for non-school traffic and emergency vehicles.*

As you come to the roundabout from Meru Desa Park please stay and queue in the right-hand lane, *leaving the left-hand lane free for non-school traffic, emergency vehicles and school traffic wanting the left-hand lane approach.* You should cross over the roundabout into the right-hand approach lane.

Please join us as we encourage everyone to practice patience, consideration and courtesy on the road.
