WHAT WE OFFER

This will culminate in the UPSR examination by the Malaysian Examination Syndicate in Primary 6. With English as the primary mode of communication, the school enhances the strengths of the local curriculum amidst a vibrant, international environment that emphasises the use of modern teaching and learning methodologies to enhance learning.

THE CURRICULUM

Primary 1 to 6

The Malaysian National Curriculum is committed to developing the child holistically as reflected in the National Educational Philosophy.

Programmes and initiatives to develop non-academic components are present both during formal class times as well as through a variety of after-school co-curricular activities. All these will foster individual talents and interests along with building leadership skills.

Co-Curricular Activities

We offer our students a large selection of co-curricular activities (CCAs) including sports, academic and art clubs. They are a superb way of deepening existing interests and skills and acquiring new ones. Students sign up for the CCAs at the beginning of each year and will participate for the full length of the academic year. All students should aim to be involved in at least two CCAs each year.

The activities are mostly included in the school fees, although some specialised activities may incur an additional fee.

Frequently Asked Questions

When should I apply?

Although we operate a rolling admission, we recommend that you apply as early as possible to secure a place for your child. Places are limited, based on a first-come-first-served basis and some year groups have a waiting list.

Does my child need to be assessed and how will they be assessed?

Primary 1 – Children are assessed through a written assessment for Bahasa Malaysia and English.

Primary 2 onwards – Children are assessed through a written assessment for Bahasa Malaysia and take an online assessment using the Cognitive Abilities Test (CAT) which tests their Verbal, Non-Verbal, Quantitative and Spatial Ability.

What is the house system?

Every student is assigned to one of four Houses within the school. These Houses provide smaller communities within the school, allowing students to interact with staff and other students outside their own year group. Healthy competition is also established between Houses through school sports, arts and academic competitions.



Is there a buddy system?

All new arrivals are assigned with buddies to help them settle into the school routines. The Parent Teacher Association is always available to help new parents settle in to the school community.

When does the academic year begin?

The academic year begins in January every year. There are three terms in a year; starting in January, April and August respectively.
