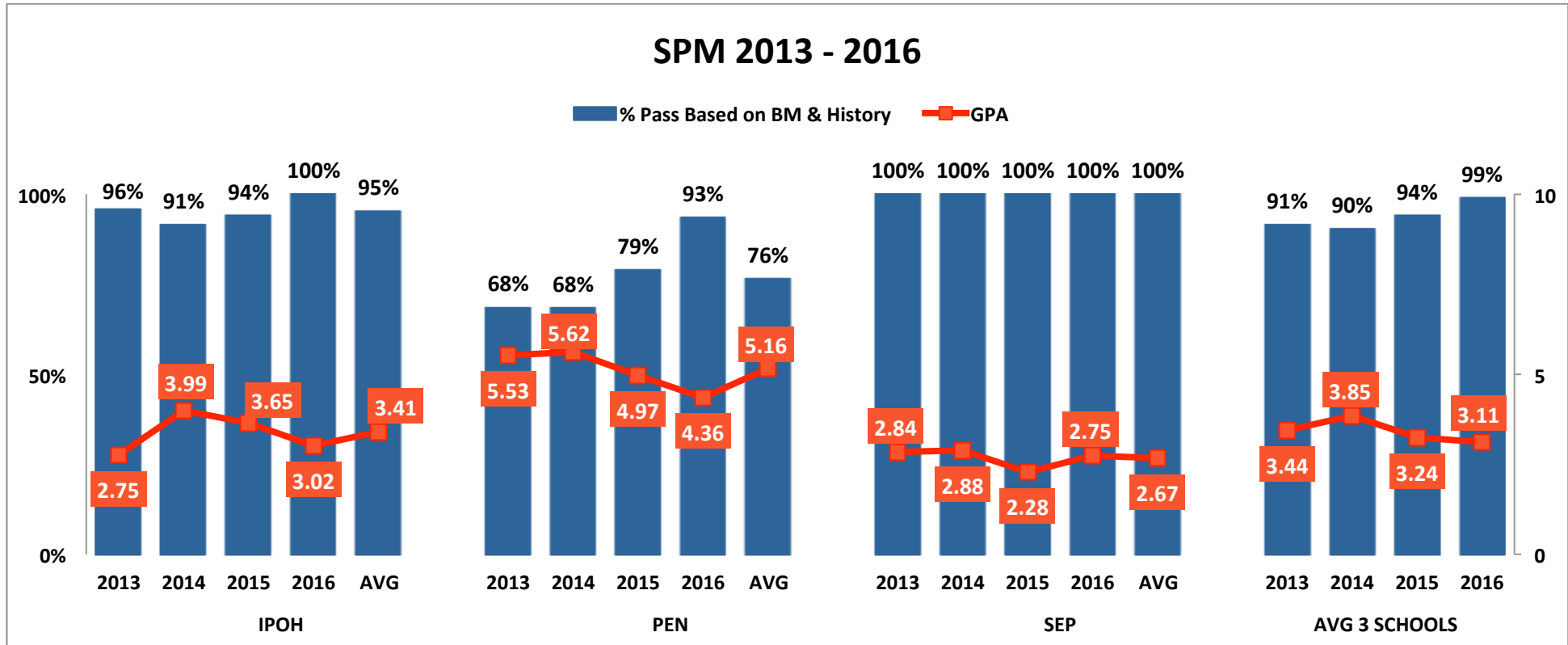

Since 2013, a pass in both Bahasa Melayu and History is a requisite for passing the SPM examination. In this respect, SEP must be commended for having 100% passes from 2013 – 2016. The 100% in Ipoh and Penang have not been so consistent with Ipoh having an average percentage pass of 95% from 2013 – 2016 and Penang having 76% for the same period. In 2016 however all 3 schools have registered the best performance since 2013 in terms of % Pass as well as GPA.

Ranking

In terms of ranking in their respective districts, Ipoh and SEP have been ranked 2nd. The details are as follows:-

In terms of top scorers, Ipoh has the highest percentage of top scorers (with 9.4%) (3 out of 32 students) followed closely by SEP with 7.0% (3 out of 43 with 7%). SEP has a drop in % from 2015 when they had 16.7% while Ipoh has seen an improvement from 9.1% (2015) to 9.4% in 2016. Though Penang has no full A's scorers. It has also shown a steady improvement in terms of the number of students scoring 5As and above with 10.5% in 2013 to 26.7% in 2016.
