

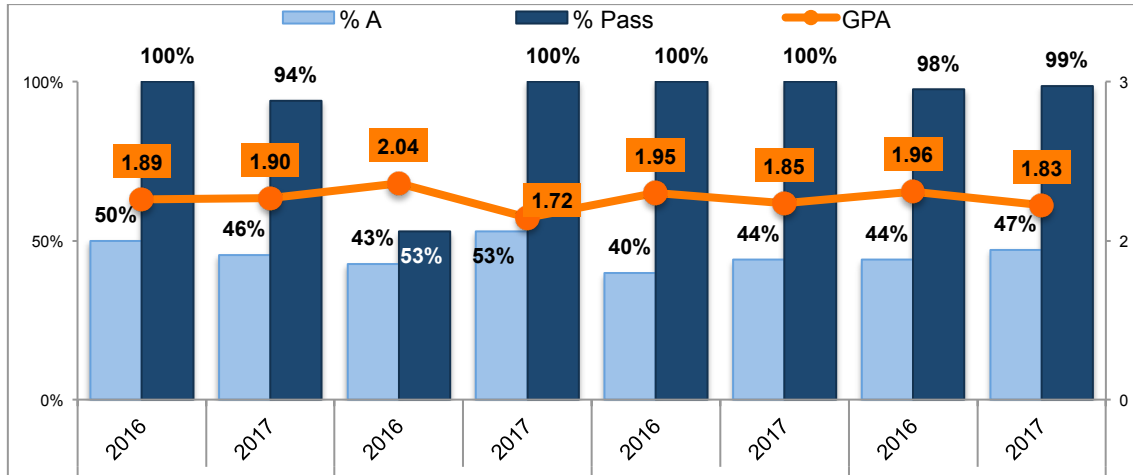

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Tenby Schools UPSR Results Analysis 2017

The format for the Standard 6 UPSR examination changed in 2016 in terms of the number of papers assessed, the type of question set and the minimum standard for a pass in the exam.

This year, the UPSR results for Tenby have shown a slight decline in terms of the Group Percentage Pass of 97.6% compared to 98.6% in 2016, and the Grade Point Average of 1.96 compared to 1.83 in 2016.

However, in terms of group percentage of students scoring A's in all the subjects assessed, the percentage for 2017 (47.1%) is an improvement from 44% in 2016. The GPA for the 6 subjects also shows an improvement except for Malay Language (Essay) and English Language (Comprehension).

Penang too has the best percentage of A's for Malay (Essay)

Only Ipoh and Penang have students with full A's (Ipoh 2, Penang 2). The percentage of students scoring 4 A's and above has improved in 2017 (32.9%) when compared to 27.8% in 2016. In both years the subject of concern is Malay Language (Comprehension) with a group GPA of 2.43 (2017) and 2.72 (2016) – the weakest GPA among the 6 subjects.
